

Never Trivialize Your Inner Dreams.

Journal your Dreams...even in the midnight hour...fragmented dreams...odd dreams...weird dreams...strange dreams are even worthy of documentation.

Often, we speak laughingly and dismissively of our friends night dreams as, "you ate too much pizza...you should not have taken that Nyquil."

Whether You Experience The Night Dreams During Your Sleep or Mind-Dream During The Day of Something You Want In Your Future...*Your Imagined Dreams Have Great Power*.

God Will Use Dreams To Talk To You.

When God talks to *families*...He talks through the *children*.

When God talks to *nations*...He talks through the *economy*.

God uses Dreams for your *protection*...similar to when the life of Jesus was being protected.

God even gives Dreams to *evil* men...Pharaoh...Nebuchadnezzar...to warn or document Divine mercy.

Your *responsibility is to interpret the Dream accurately*. If you cannot find the answer...at least document it until someone is able to help you interpret the Dream.

Avoid trivializing even your night dreams.

Dreams may *encourage* or *motivate* you to intercede for someone...to become more *attentive to a parent*.

God wants you to record your dreams...document the Night Dream.

Your Mind-Dream Is Different Than Your Night Dream. We use this same phraseology when we talk about an *invisible* picture of a future we desire.

- What is the Picture you have of your future?
- What is your Dream for a new house?
- What is your Dream for starting a business?
- What are your Dreams for your children?
- What is your most Dominant Dream this very Moment?

• Are you willing to devote all your time and attention to it?

• Are you willing to create a plan that will make it happen?

4 Expectations of The Uncommon Dream

1. The Uncommon Dream May Appear Impossible.

2. The Uncommon Dream Is What You Want To Be, Do or Have.

3. The Uncommon Dream Will Energize You To Leave The Present And Enter Your Future.

4. An Uncommon Future Will Require Uncommon Preparation. You see, the most wonderful thing that can happen to a Dream is a specific plan of action.

Planning Always Produces Self-Confidence. It is one of the Golden Secrets of the Uncommon Dreamer.

Reassess and re-evaluate your personal goals.

The greatest goal in my life today is staying in The Secret Place of prayer and writing what The Holy Spirit teaches me through His Word and daily experiences.

20 Keys To Unleashing Your Uncommon Dream

1. Invest One Hour In Writing Down Clearly The Goals That Really Matter To You At This Point. Keep this list confidential and private. "Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it," (Habakkuk 2:2).

2. Permit Unexciting Dreams of Yesterday To Die. Stop pursuing yesterday goals that no longer excite you. Do not feel obligated to keep trying to obtain them...if you no longer have a true passion for them. (See Isaiah 43:18-19.)

3. Do Not Depend On Others To Understand Your Dreams And Goals. Permit them freedom for their chosen focus, also. They have every right to choose what they love. Refuse to be intimidated by their efforts to persuade you to move in a different direction with your life.

4. Never Make Permanent Decisions Because of Temporary

Feelings. One young woman got so excited about a new friend; she dropped the lease on her own apartment and moved into the apartment of her new friend. Within a week, she realized she had made a mistake. They were not compatible in a close environment. *Time Will Expose What Interrogation Cannot*.

5. Avoid Intimate Relationships With Those Who Do Not Really Respect Your Dreams. You will have to sever ties. *Wrong people do not always leave your life voluntarily*. Life is too short to permit discouragers close to you. "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them," (Ephesians 5:11). *Those Who Disagree With Your Goals Will Usually Disagree With Your Decisions*.

6. Anticipate Changes In Your Needs And Goals. Your present feelings and opinions are rarely permanent. New experiences are coming. New relationships are ahead.

When you *assess* and *evaluate* your goals, you will unclutter your life of the unnecessary. *Prioritize* your most important goals.

7. Nobody Can Determine Your Own Goals For You. You must decide what generates joy in your own heart. *Your Focus Decides Your Feelings*.

8. Different People Have Different Goals. What is important to me may be very unimportant to another. When others come in my presence, our *differences emerge*.

One of my personal goals involves a Wisdom Mentorship Program For Families. It will be a 10-year Mentorship Program For Parents...consisting of 120 Wisdom books. (There will be a chapter for each day of the month.) This will be a Mentorship System for parents to use with their children ages 6 to 16. This provides parents with a "Wisdom Encyclopedia" for their family.

Imagine this incredible picture! Begin each morning during breakfast...reading one chapter and mentoring your children on such topics as: 31 Facts about God, 31 Facts about Jesus, 31 Facts about The Holy Spirit, and other powerful, *life-changing* themes.

You, too, can develop your own Focus and Plan for your life.

9. Do Not Wait For Others To Inspire You Regarding Your Dreams. Your friends may distract you and not have the same values you are pursuing.

Accept their different values. The Difference In People Is The Future They Are Pursuing.

10. You Must Determine What Your Goals Are Financially,

Spiritually or Physically. Others cannot borrow your goals. You may have wonderful goals for those you love, but if they do not have the same Dream for themselves *it is a waste of your time and energy*.

Some years ago, I purchased a special building for a physical fitness center for my staff. I was so excited. I hired a trainer to assist each of my staff in developing their maximum level of health. The excitement lasted one month.

At the end of 3 weeks, only two people would show up at the special meeting with the trainer that was costing me \$75 an hour. Although the fee for the trainer had been paid for them, they simply did not have any *personal* fitness goals.

My *investment* was wasted. You cannot attempt to control the lives of others.

11. Avoid Intimate Relationships With People Who Disrespect Your Dreams. Yes, you may minister to them in the crisis moments of their lives. You can encourage and speak words that will strengthen and bless them. *Access Is First A Gift, Then A Test, Then A Reward.*

- *Intimacy* should be earned.
- *Access* should be a privilege.
- *Relationship* should be a reward for *respect*.

12. Place Pictures of Your Goals And Dreams On The Walls of Your Home And Office. For example, if you have a Dream of losing weight, place pictures that *inspire you* and excite you to lose those unwanted pounds.

Do you have a Dream of owning your own home? What you keep looking at *continuously* will influence your conversation and your faith. *What You See Determines What You Desire.*

13. Write Out Your Dream On Paper. "Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it," (Habakkuk 2:2).

Some do not make plans because they simply have never been taught how to create a plan.

14. Write Your Personal Definition of Success. Document the most *specific, clear and simple definition* of what you want to accomplish.

15. Write Down 5 Reasons You Want To Succeed. Keep a list of those you love who will succeed *because of your fulfilled Dream*. This is very important. Their countenance and their own joy will motivate you

during difficult days.

16. Write Down Every Detail Involved In Achieving Your Dream. Every *step*...every *detail* you can think of. It might be easier to dictate. It is proven we talk 6 times faster than we write.

17. Write Down Every Question You Should Be Asking. Solutions will be birthed the Moment you focus on the quality of your questions. *The Quality of Your Questions Will Determine The Quality of Your Answers.*

18. Write Down The Names of Those Who Can Participate In Your Dream. Write at the top of the page, "My Circle of Counsel For My Dream." This will be those who brainstorm and provide feedback and advice regarding your Dream. Accepting the help and gifts of others in your life will accelerate your achievements.

Stay in the center of your own expertise. Do not attempt to be an expert in everything. I have made this mistake. Rather than hire experts, I have the tendency to want to learn about everything. That will slow you down.

Avoid focusing only on learning...strive for completion of your goals.

Focus your time and energy on a single Dream or Goal. You Will Only Have Significant Success With Something That Is An Obsession.

19. Respect And Reward Every Relationship Committed To Birthing The Uncommon Dream of Your Life. It guarantees satisfaction.

20. Learn To Generate Excitement In Others To Get Them Involved With The Uncommon Dream.

The Uncommon Dream Will Birth The Uncommon Life.

THE UNCOMMON DREAM WILL REQUIRE UNCOMMON SELF-CONFIDENCE



Self-Confidence Is Magnetic.

Thoughts have a presence. Whatever you are thinking about will influence the atmosphere around you. It stirs the heart of those who do not have self-confidence. It creates a desire in others...*they want to be in your presence.*

3 Keys To Self-Confidence

1. Know Your Assignment. You were created to solve a problem. Discover what it is.

Your *Assignment* is any problem you were created to solve while you are here on earth. You must be persuaded you are truly in the center of where you belong.

2. Know Your Dominant Gift. It could be organization, computers, administration or communication. Knowing your *difference* from others will birth remarkable inner peace. Your Significance Is Not In Your Similarity To Another, But In Your Point of Difference From Another.

3. Identify Your Persuasions. When I walk to the pulpit or platform to speak, I never lack confidence. I feel that I know my subject more than anyone present does! It is why I am there. I stay in the center of my Belief System.

Exploration and experimenting is different than my core *confidence* in my beliefs.

You have to know more about your chosen subject than others around you do...to generate confidence. Information Births Confidence.

7 Steps That Can Unlock Your Self-Confidence

1. Recognize That Your Creator Wants Good Things For You.

"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning," (James 1:17).

2. Verify That Your Dream Is Not Contrary To The Laws of God or Man. Avoid anything that condemns your inner invisible referee...your conscience. Your conscience must be at peace for your greatest ideas to emerge. You must not attempt to pursue anything that troubles your *heart*, soul and mind. The Seeds of Greatness Grow Best In The Soil of Peace.

3. Fill Every Conversation With Faith-Talk About Your Dream. *Words matter.* They move you toward your Dream or away from it. Your words should *continuously* reflect hope in your future. When someone speaks to you with doubt and unbelief, *boldly refute those words.* Do not receive them. *Replace their evil report with your own good report.*

Inform others of the great things that are happening in your life. Remember, your faith is like a muscle that grows and becomes strong through *continuous* use. *Your Words Are The Seeds For Feelings*.

4. Pursue Access of Those Whose Fire Burns Brighter Than Your Own. Who are the most successful people you presently know?

Who are the people who have succeeded in the same arena in which you desire to succeed?

Schedule appointments with them...a special lunch. *Interrogate*, *interview* and *receive* the information they have.

Do not feel obligated to tell them all of your plans. *Respect and humbly pursue their advice and counsel.* Let them light your fire as often as possible.

Every Friendship Nurtures A Strength or A Weakness.

5. Remember That Your Own Dream Is A Special Seed You Are Sowing Into The Hearts of Others. Sometimes, they are excited and thrilled with you. However, there will be times when those closest to you are not ready to receive what you want to share.

A farmer knows his field requires preparation before he plants his seed. Likewise, the minds and hearts of those you love may require preparation as well. *Be patient*.

6. Remember That Your Dream May Intimidate Those Close To You And Make Them Feel Uncomfortable. It is important to remember that your Dream is yours alone. Others do not *feel* what you feel, *see* what you see, or *know* what you know. *How can they understand your joy when they have not lived with your sorrow?* Those closest to you may *misread* you or even *misjudge* you because they feel uncomfortable. Forcing them to respond to your Dream, and your enthusiasm may be intimidating.

Perhaps, they are "*unstretched*." You are excited about success, while they are hoping only to *survive*.

7. Keep Your Fire Fueled. Fertilize your own dreams. *Talk* about them. Build on them. You cannot expect to light someone else's fire until you have lit the fire *within yourself*.

Desire Is The Greatest Seed You Could Possess. You are reading this book. It is proof of your desire...your need...to succeed. Fuel this obsession.

- Desire Determines What You Learn.
- Desire Determines What You Pursue.
- Desire Creates Endurance And Strength.
- Desire Separates You From The Common Person.
- Desire Makes It Possible To Leave Egypt...And Move Toward Canaan.

The Battle of Your Life Is For Your Mind. The Battle of The Mind Is For Focus. The Uncommon Dream Must Qualify For Your Undivided Focus.

Your Health Affects Your Focus

Rest Produces Hope. When you are mentally at rest, your mind moves to *positive* things, *wonderful* and *glorious* dreams...things you want to do and accomplish.

When you are weary, you are not the same person. You do not have the same kind of *faith...enthusiasm* or *patience*.

When you are *rested*, strengthened and well in your spirit...your faith is renewed. Your Focus Decides Your Feelings.

Fatigue Can Become Deadly. When you are tired at night, things that would normally seem simple...suddenly feel very burdensome and complex to you.

Tasks that usually take minimal effort suddenly seem too much to complete. You may even blame others when things go wrong.

Faith does not always flow easily through a tired body. *Tired Eyes Rarely See A Great Future*.

Fatigue Is An Enemy To Your Focus. Many have failed because of exhaustion, over-scheduling and attempting too many tasks in a day.

The famed billionaire, J. Paul Getty once said, "I have seen as many people fail from attempting too many things as those who attempt too little."

11 Mistakes Fatigue Will Create

1. Fatigue Makes Mountains You Are Facing...Appear Bigger.

2. Fatigue Causes Valleys You Are Experiencing...Appear Deeper.

3. Fatigue Magnifies The Pain of Offenses.

4. Fatigue Births Impatience...With Those You Work Around.

5. Fatigue Creates An Obsession With Immediate Results Instead of The Protocol For Achieving Them.

6. Fatigue Turns Your Focus To Short-Term Goals Rather Than Long-Term Goals.

2. Focus Will Expose The Unqualified In Your Life. When you decide to do right...wrong people will want to leave your life.

3. Focus Forces Adversaries To Become Exposed. Your chosen focus is the world you have created for your mind.

4. Your Focus Decides Your Personal Reaction of Yourself And Others.

When *Jesus* began to talk about His deity, His enemies reacted with intense anger and hatred.

God is a Planner. Anyone who schedules supper 6,000 years in advance...is a Master organizer.

The Uncommon Dream will take a gigantic leap forward once you invest your time in a detailed plan. Details increase your confidence.

God commended ants for their planning. "Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest," (Proverbs 6:6-8).

Doubters Can Become Believers...When They See The Plan.

Plans require time. They are laborious...not always easy.

- Anything You Can See Becomes Believable.
- Anything Believable Becomes Achievable.

Years ago, I had a product that would greatly bless a religious organization. I met with 12 of their board members.

The least wealthy of the board members had a net worth of \$40 million. I showed how my product would increase a profit of \$25 million for their company. At the beginning, they said it would take several weeks before they could accept my product.

I decided to invest \$850 in developing a visual flip chart...*a plan to show them what I could see in my mind*. When you take time to write out a clear plan...others see your plan, and have the confidence to get involved.

They decided that night to adopt the plan. Later, some complications arose and the organization divided. But I discovered that *persuasion is in clarity. When Others See What You Are Seeing, They Will Feel What You Are Feeling.*

Failure To Plan Will Derail Your Dream

Your life is like the *Golden Train of Success on the Track of Success*, and God schedules *Cities of Accomplishments* in your future.

Every morning, God gives you 24 Golden *Boxcars*. What you schedule in those 24 Golden *Hours*, determines the speed and the distance your train will move.

If you do not plan what goes in those 24 hours...those 24 Golden Boxcars, somebody else is going to fill them for you with their own set of tasks.

Have you ever had somebody come in and dump into your 24 Golden Boxcars? Have you ever had your train derailed for a day?

It happens when you fail to schedule your day. Yesterday Is In The Tomb; Tomorrow Is In The Womb. The Only Place You Will Ever Be Is Today.

If you cannot make 24 hours go right, how can you make 24 years go right? If you cannot make one day go in the right direction, how are you going to make your whole life go right?

Few understand planning. Planning is extremely difficult. It requires walking away from *secondary* desires.

Write down 7 daily goals. Keep it simple.

1. 7:00 - Read my Bible.

2. 7:30 - Get dressed.

3. 9:00 - Clean my room.

All People Who Have Great Dreams And Goals...Have Detailed Plans. All the multi-millionaires that you hear about have plans that you would not believe. Their plans are listed...they are *written*. They have staff to assist them to do nothing but layout maps for their life...and they do accomplish their dreams.

This is what we want to help you do...develop a map for your life.

Where do you want to be in 1 year, 5 years, 10 years and 20 years; should Jesus tarry? You must have a plan to work with. You can always *change it, alter it, add to it or delete it.*

A Dream must be so big that it enters every conversation and anything else discussed becomes boring to you. *Your Whole Worth In Life Links To The Problems You Are Willing To Solve.*

What Is The Greatest Dream In Your Heart? When I say, Bill Gates, you know he is all about...*Computers*. Evander Holyfield...*Boxing*. Thomas Edison...*Inventions*. Benny Hinn...*Healing*. Billy Graham...*Salvation*.

If I say your name and you cannot tell me in one single sentence what your Dream is...you do not yet know what your Dream is.

If you do not know your Dream, nobody else knows it, which means...nobody will participate in it. Your Dream must consume you. *You Will Only Have Significant Success With Something That Is An Obsession*.

Anticipate Demonic Distractions

Satan Never Reacts To Your Past. He Reacts To Your Future. The abortion issue is greater than a murder issue. It is a satanic strategy to stop the entry of deliverers into a generation. He tried it with Jesus. He tried it with Moses...and he will try it with you.

Take time to build your Dream on God's schedule. There are two ways to get out of God's will...to move ahead or lag behind.

In The Secret Place, you must listen for *directions* and timing to achieve anything with God's approval. Stay in His presence *long enough*...then you will discover His Plan.

One Hour In The Presence of God Will Reveal The Flaws of Your Most Carefully Laid Plans.

The Bible Is A Collection of God's Plans. "For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?" (Luke 14:28).

A *thought* is not a plan.

A wish is not a plan.

A *possibility* is not a plan.

True champions invest time and energy to develop a clear-cut goal and Dream. They plan for their life.

The entire universe reveals planning...*by a Divine Force*. It is said that if we were a few miles closer to the sun, we would burn up. If we were a few miles farther away from the sun, we would freeze to death.

God Respects Men Who Plan. God respects men who believe in their Dream enough to labor over a plan.

The Divine purpose for prosperity is to continue provision during difficult times. A Dream is partially for preparation. It is not a prediction in every case. There is truth in the phrase, "short-time pain for long-time gain."

Jesus prepared 30 years...for three-and-a-half years of ministry.

Moses prepared 80 years...to become the deliverer for the Israelites.

Successful books require years of research and gathering of data and knowledge.

Someone told me that the height of a tree was equal to the length of the root beneath the soil.

The *taller* the tree...*the longer the roots*. The *stronger* the tree *determines* the number of years.

The Quality of Your Preparation Will Determine The Quality of Your Future.

8 Rewards of Preparation

Anything God Loves...Hell Hates.

A Dream From God Will Activate The Enemies of God. An Uncommon Dream will activate Uncommon Adversity...Uncommon Enemies.

When Satan Wants To Destroy You, He Puts A Person Into Your Life.

An Uncontested Enemy Will Flourish. Do not "come down off the wall" as Nehemiah was wise to do. "And I sent messengers unto them, saying, I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down: why should the work cease, whilst I leave it, and come down to you?" (Nehemiah 6:3).

When Oral Roberts began to build the city of Faith...58 floors...his obsession was to combine medicine with the healing of God. He wanted others to know that God uses *physicians and medicine*. He called it *the Gospel for the Whole Man*. God simply wants us well. Life is not just for preparing us for eternity but we can enjoy the here and now. What you eat *matters*. Exercise *matters...in every area*...taking care of your body...*matters*.

But, when Dr. Roberts announced the building of the City of Faith, many doctors rose up against him with anger and tried to destroy his Dream.

Doctors who had taken the oath that they would give themselves to the *healing* and the *health* of people were so angry. They felt it would affect the finances in the other hospitals.

5 Reasons Enemies Are Necessary

You Will Always Have An Enemy. Jesus knew this. "And ye shall be hated by all men for My name's sake: but he that endureth to the end the same shall be saved," (Matthew 10:22). Jesus was perfect and still had an

enemy.

1. Enemies Expose Your Weakness. Enemies birth humility...a magnet to others and to God Himself. Humility is the recognition of what you do not have. It births the ability to value what others do possess.

Nobody Else Can Be Like You.

Whatever Is Inside You Will Change Everyone Around You. God planned you. You are unlike anyone else on earth.

Here is the account of Joseph in the book of Genesis. The life of Joseph excites Uncommon Achievers. Joseph's Dreams brought rewards to his family. "And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: For, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf. And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? Or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me. And he told it to his father, and to his brethren: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What is this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? And his brethren envied him; but his father observed the saying," (Genesis 37:5-11).

Famine would have destroyed the Egyptians but Joseph was *their reward*. *He had the ability to interpret dreams*, which proved to be a message from God to Pharaoh.

Your Significance Is Not In Your Similarity To Another, But In Your Point of Difference From Another. Grasp this.

God is not a duplicator. He is a creator. You are perfect and genetically accurate for solving a specific problem for somebody on earth.

It is important that you realize you are not needed everywhere. You are needed at a specific place, time and for a specific person. Do not take offense at this. It is all in God's plan.

Joseph's brothers hated the attention his father showed him. They despised his *distinction*.

Joseph says, "Here I pray you this dream which I have dreamed," and he

explains the Dream to them. Nothing is more shocking than to trust those who do not trust you.

Why did Joseph tell his brothers?

Because when God puts something in your heart...you want to share it. When God puts a Dream inside you...a goal...a picture of something you can do or have...you want to involve others.

Your Dream is different from your Assignment.

Your Assignment is the problem you solve.

Your *Dream* is the reward you receive for doing your Assignment. God did not give Joseph a picture of his responsibilities. He gave him a picture of his rewards.

An Uncommon Dream From God Will Create Separation. Those closest to you may not understand. Opposition will often come from those closest to you. Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery but God protected him. God had a plan to fulfill in his life. "The Lord was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man," (Genesis 39:2). Joseph found grace in His eyes. The Lord blessed the Egyptians.

Potiphar's wife was attracted to Joseph. She wanted him. She pursued him *desperately*, but he continually refused. Yet, she falsely accused him for something he did not do. Everyone *believed* her. *Yes, this could happen to you, too.* Many ministers have even experienced a crucifixion of their credibility in the media.

Joseph Became A Problem-Solver In A Prison He Did Not Deserve. Joseph kept a sweet spirit. He did not discuss the false accusations. Meditation, Mind, Conversations...give life. Stop discussing what you want to die.

Paint Your Mind With The Uncommon Dream

Elijah "painted the picture" of a Dream for the widow of Zarephath (see 1 Kings 17).

She could not Dream anymore. Her Dream had died when she saw her sickened son dying. This was their last meal. God had turned off the brook's supply.

God brought Elijah to the widow's house to breathe new life into her Dream. It was the Dream that provoked her to *obedience*.

The greatness of Elijah did not impress the widow. Neither did his *charisma*, his *anointed* words...nor his *aura* impress her.

She simply heard a man of God saying...her provision cruise of oil would not fail. She would not have to worry about her future. *God would supply*.

Elijah painted an Uncommon Dream on her mind. She decided to believe it.

3. The Uncommon Mentor Will Not Compliment You. He Will Correct You.

4. The Uncommon Mentor Will Not Justify Your Failure. He Will Expose The Reason For It.

5. The Uncommon Mentor Does Not Ignore Your Flaws. He Helps You Overcome Them.

6. The Uncommon Mentor Is An Experienced Adviser. He Sees Something You Do Not See.

7. The Uncommon Mentor Will Know Something You Do Not Know.

8. The Uncommon Mentor Will See Possible Pitfalls And Potential Traps That You Cannot See.

Mentors Impart Credibility

One of my favorite illustrations is about the old lawyer who had lunch with the young lawyer who just graduated from college.

Going back to his office after lunch, the old, legendary and famous lawyer draped his arm on the shoulder of the youthful one.

They walked slowly back to their offices. Many people saw them.

When the young lawyer walked back in his own office, he was so discouraged. He had hoped for some recommendations from the lawyer on specific cases. He had wanted the old lawyer to give him some of his business.

The young lawyer was almost destitute financially. He knew it takes time to get your own clients and build integrity in the eyes of a community.

"He could have given me several cases that would have made all the difference in the world for me," he cried dejectedly to himself.

However, the next week several phone calls came. In the coming weeks, numerous cases came his way. What had happened?

Those who had observed that the legendary lawyer was conferring and associating with the young lawyer started believing in the potential and future of the young lawyer. I call it the "*transference of credibility*."

You will need people who can share their experiences with you. Some have tasted failure, and others can share the specific reasons why they did not fail.

Make a connection with someone whose influence you admire! You

need those who will correct you and make you think twice about an important decision.

Encouragers are vital. You will need and benefit from honest confrontation. One of my biggest regrets is failure to have qualified honest people who would confront me about decisions and directions I was taking over the years.

Favor Is When Others Want To Help You. They believe in you. Sometimes, they do not even understand why this mysterious desire to aid you even exists. However, their Wisdom can make your life a thousand times easier.

Reach for intercessors.

Reach for Mentors. Especially those who are *Godly, mature* and *compassionate...seasoned.* "Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father which is in Heaven," (Matthew 18:19).

A young man who was traveling with me was telling everybody he was my protégé.

I stopped him and said, "Tell me the last 3 questions you have asked me." *He could not name one*.

I said, "You have made serious choices that affect the rest of your life without even consulting me. In fact, you have done it secretly. I do not want anyone to think I am accountable for the kinds of decisions you have made. That is an embarrassment to me." *The Pursuit of The Mentor Reveals The Passion of The Protégé*.

Your Choice of Mentors Reveals Much

- When I know who is Mentoring You... I will know your priorities.
- When I see Naomi, *I know what Ruth contains*.
- When I listen to Paul, *I have the information Timothy used for decisionmaking*.
- When I look at Mordecai, I can discern the principles inside of Esther.
- When I study the life of Moses, I understand the turning points of Joshua.

Your Mentor May Not Be Your Best Friend

- Your Best Friend loves you the way you are. Your Mentor loves you too much to leave you the way you are.
- Your Best Friend is comfortable with your past. Your Mentor is comfortable with your future.
- Your Best Friend will risk your success to keep your approval. Your Mentor will risk your affection to help you succeed.

8 Hindrances To Recognizing The Uncommon Mentor

1. Pride Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. The Pharisees were filled with pride and did not recognize Jesus the Son of God.

2. Guilt Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. When people feel guilty over a sin in their lives...the presence of a holy man will intimidate them.

3. Jealousy Often Blinds You To The Uncommon Mentor. Jealousy and envy have robbed us of many blessings God has in store for us.

4. Wrong Voices of Influence Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. It is dangerous when parents speak disrespectfully about a man of God in the presence of their children.

5. Prejudiced Mentors Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. Be careful to not *unconsciously* perpetuate prejudices of others.

6. Arrogance Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. The arrogance of Haman blinded him to the greatness of Mordecai.

7. Your Personal Agenda Can Blind You To The Uncommon Mentor. It is important to recognize a man of God even when you fail to hear the Voice of God *personally*.

8. Familiarity Often Blinds You To The Uncommon Mentor. Pastors experience this often. Because their congregations see them often...their humanity is evident and too often people focus on *weaknesses*. Family members suffer greatly because of *familiarity*.

3 Habits That Can Change Your Life

2. Enter The Secret Place For Prayer...At The Same Time Each Morning. Where You Are Determines What You Hear; What You Hear Determines What You Believe.

Birds require air. Fish require water. Uncommon men and women of God require the presence of God. Pursue His presence. Get alone with Him.

The Secret Place is the only place you will receive Uncommon Wisdom *without the stain of human logic and limitations*.

3. Read The Word of God Each Morning...Without Fail. His Word is His Wisdom. The wisest man who ever lived decreed, "Wisdom is the principal thing," (Proverbs 4:7). Your Dream Will Require Miracles. Your Father refuses to be forgotten and ignored.

- Miracles Will Require God.
- God Requires Obedience.

When *Joshua and the Israelites* approached Jericho, it took a *miracle* for the walls to come down.

When *Gideon and his 300 men* took on the huge array of Midianites, victory required an absolute *miracle*.

When *Naaman* dipped in the Jordan River to receive healing of his leprosy, it took a *miracle* for the healing to occur.

When the *wine* ran out at the marriage in Cana, it took a *miracle* of Jesus for the water in the water pots to turn into wine.

When the *widow of Zarephath* was eating her last meal, it required a *miracle* for it to multiply. *God never gives you a Dream that does not require His participation*.

The Uncommon Dream will not happen without your constant awareness that it will take the hand of God to make it happen.

God will never involve Himself in a Dream that you can accomplish *alone*.

The purpose of every single act of God is to increase your dependency upon Him and your addiction to His presence.

12 Keys To Unlock Miracles For Your Dreams

1. Recognize The Uncommon Dream You Desire Will Require Miracles From God. *You will not succeed alone.*

2. Expect Miracles In Your Life Daily. "For he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek

Him," (Hebrews 11:6).

3. Remember Miracles Will Require A Continuous Flow of Faith. "But without faith it is impossible to please Him," (Hebrews 11:6).

4. Feed Your Faith—Confidence In God. It enters your heart when you hear the words of God spoken. "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God," (Romans 10:17).

5. Understand That The Logic of Your Mind And The Faith of Your Heart Collide. They will wage war with each other continually as you search to discover and achieve your Dream. "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would do. But the fruit of the Spirit is...faith," (Galatians 5:17, 22).

6. Logic Produces Order; Faith Produces Miracles. God will never consult your logic to determine your future. *He permits your faith to determine the levels of your promotion and victories.*

7. Logic Is The Wonderful And Valuable Gift He Gives You To Create Order In Your Dealings With People.

8. Faith Is The Wonderful And Valuable Gift He Gives You To Create Miracles...Through The Father.

9. The Fulfillment of The Uncommon Dream Will Require Miracle Relationships With Mentors, Protégés, Friends And Golden Connections. For example, Joseph would never have entered the palace without the miracle relationship with the butler, *a Divine Connection*.

10. The Uncommon Dream May Require Supernatural Financial Provision. For example, Peter experienced the miracle of the coin in the mouth of the fish to pay his taxes. *Financial miracles are normal in the lives of those who obey God.*

11. The Uncommon Dream Will Require The Miracle of Wisdom. Your decisions will open doors or close doors. *Each decision you make will decrease you or increase you.*

12. Miracles Come Easily To The Obedient. "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land," (Isaiah 1:19).

Any Move Toward Self-Sufficiency Is A Move Away From God. You must cultivate continuous gratefulness and thankfulness in your heart for the presence of The Holy Spirit. *Check His countenance. Pursue His approval.* "The Lord make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The Lord lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace," (Numbers 6:25-26).

Remember, Your Dream Will Require Miracles.

Wrong Dreams Become Substitutes For The Right Dreams. It is very important that you do not pursue a Dream or Goal that God did not instruct you to pursue. When you pursue something God did not instruct you to have, He is not obligated to sustain you *emotionally, physically or financially.*

Anything You Pursue Alone Will Fail.

After David had conquered his enemies, he was sitting in his house. He indicated to Nathan, the prophet, that he wanted to build a special house for God. The prophet immediately responded, "Go, do all that is in thine heart; for the Lord is with thee," (2 Samuel 7:3).

Even Prophets Can Be Wrong When They Fail To Consult God. That evening God spoke to Nathan to bring a special word to David. David was not to build the house of the Lord.

Rather, God had established that David's Seed would do so instead. "I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build an house for My name," (2 Samuel 7:12-13). Mentors often see the future of their protégés years in advance.

Never exclude The Holy Spirit from your pursuit of His Dream in your life.

Strength Is The Product of Focus.

Have you decided The Dream for your life? It cannot be something suggested by friends or family or anyone else. It cannot be your Mother's Dream.

The Uncommon Dream Will Create The Uncommon Life. It Must Be Your Own Dream.

Who Are You Learning From?

What Are You Learning From Them?

What Are You Presently Learning?

Is Your Learning Related To Your Dream?

Your learning needs to be connected to your passion. You Can Only Do... What You See Internally And Outwardly.

The Uncommon Dream Will Require Time. The Uncommon Dream must become so important, that it dominates every conversation.

Have you ever heard a mother talking excitedly about a baby soon to be born? You might start talking about someone named Bill. She interrupts with, "Bill, that is a good name. That is a good name for this baby." Then you start talking about The United Nations and the same mother-to-be says, "Oh, I hope he does go around the world someday. That would be wonderful!"

What has happened? *That baby is the Mother's Dream and is the only topic important in her mind.*

Your Dream Must Grow. That is how you know a Dream is from God. It is *designed...stirred* and is *growing*.

- *How much Time are you willing to invest daily in your Dream?*
- How much Money are you willing to invest?
- *How much Effort are you willing to invest toward your Dream?*
- Who has helped you and inspired you to achieve your Dream?
- Who are the people that need to be inspired to be involved in your *Dream*?

• Whose Dream are you helping to fulfill?

Friends are shaping and sculpturing what you value. When you have a Dream, identify those who consistently believe in you.

The Quality of Your Uncommon Dream Does Not Guarantee The Fulfillment of Your Dream. Adolf Hitler had a horrible Dream, things he wanted to destroy. Unfortunately, he achieved those dreams. You can have a worthy Dream and still never achieve it. You can focus on an evil Dream and obtain it. Divine laws work for everyone.

You Must Define Your Dream, Refine It And Confine Your Life To It.

- God Had A Dream...in Adam.
- Martin Luther King Had A Dream...bring deliverance to his people.
- Joseph Had A Dream...sustain others during a famine.
- Jesus Had A Dream...to seek and save that which was lost. Jesus "...for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross," (Hebrews 12:2).

The picture you keep looking at determines the strength that enters you. **What Picture Dominates Your Mind?**

God desires to work in you.

He is watching you...observing you, and has a great interest in your success in life. "That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God," (Ephesians 3:16-19).

Your Success Is God's Dream!

God wants you to have an understanding of His plan, His intentions toward you. God is so interested in your life that He can exceed what you are thinking about. He can *even* exceed the desires of your heart. "Now unto him who is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us," (Ephesians 3:20).

Your Focus Creates Strength

There was a little girl trapped beneath the weight of a 1,500-pound car. Her mother lifted the car off of her. Later, the mother was unable to lift even 200 pounds. But, her child had been under the car. *She was able to lift that car because her child was her focus*. Strength is not the product of a muscle; it is the product of a focus.

Every satanic strategy in your life is to break your focus on God.

The Uncommon Dream Is An Invisible Picture of Your Future. Example: Jesus, for the joy that was set before Him, endured the cross. Jesus did not go to the cross; *He went through the cross, to the resurrection*. The photograph in the mind of Christ was not, "I am going to the cross." In His mind...He went through the crucifixion, to the resurrection, and now He is at the right hand of the throne of God. *The picture of His reward...you and me...enabled Him to endure the tortuous ordeal of The Cross*.

I Cannot Change What Is In Your Hand, Until I Can Change What Is In Your Head. The picture is what carries you through to fulfill every Dream God has given you.

I Cannot Change Your Provisions, Until I Change Your Photograph. I have to change the picture, what you keep seeing controls what you feel.

Power Facts To Remember

You will not change your life until you change the vision. Whatever you keep seeing on the inside of you, is what your faith will operate on.

Passion Is Intense Energized Desire.

13 Exciting Facts About Passion

1. Passion Is A Current. *It decides what comes toward you or moves away from you.*

Water has currents.

Air has currents.

Passion creates currents in life.

2. Passion Is An Irresistible Magnet That Pulls Others Toward You To Participate. Focus births passion. Feed it and it will become strong desire. Feed it continuously and it will become an obsession.

3. Passion Creates Favor. *Currents of Favor* flow toward the person who is passionate and confident toward their Dream.

Currents of Favor Begin To Flow The Moment That You Solve A Problem For Someone.

4. Your Passion Decides Who Is Comfortable With You. *If you are passionate...your persuasion will be evident*. You are responsible to generate excitement in others to get them involved with your Dream. The persuaded *persuade*.

Those close to you will fuel your fire. They will follow your passion and celebrate your focus. *However, they will need reminding and encouragement*. Those around you are meditating on their own failures. They have doubts about themselves. They may lack certainty and clarity concerning their own dreams.

In fact, I heard a public speaker say recently, "Most people want you to fail...very few want you to win." I *disagree*.

7. Passion Distinguishes You From The Crowd. Multitudes are pursuing heroes. When you are watching television you are most likely identifying with the hero, the champion...you want him to win! Others want you to win...especially those closest to you. Stand strong...follow your Dream with passion. *Be relentless in pursuit of your Dream*.

8. Passion Is The Seed Commanded To Your Environment. Success requires energy. It requires energy to move toward your goals...regardless of your circumstances, your feelings or obstacles.

9. The Passion Gap Explains Failed Marriages. *Passion will always put a distance between you and those without it.* Guard your passion. Passion is your greatest weapon.

10. Passion Decides The Speed of Your Learning. Passion decides what you are willing to study...willing to pursue...willing to endure.

11. Passion Is The Aura That Attracts Good People. Life always opens the door widest to the passionate people with purpose. Here is the story of friends of mine from Tampa, Florida. They went to Florida with nothing.

There were about 100 people in the church. I spoke at their first banquet. Recently, a woman gave them a \$400,000 building...they have been blessed with explosive favor. Today two thousand people worship together as they are reaching the inner cities of Tampa, Florida.

12. Passion Is Irresistible. Become so passionate about your Dream that it becomes an obsession. You will create an atmosphere and climate around you that others cannot resist.

13. Passion Exposes Weakness And Forces Its Submission To Your Dream. Passion Penetrates And Controls Any Environment. Those who are weak without purpose will *feel your passion*. Those who have a passion

themselves...will respect your passion.

4 Ways To Increase Your Passion

1. Unclutter Your Life of Anything That Does Not Belong In It. You cannot do everything. Unclutter your life...by uncluttering your day. Schedule fewer appointments. Choose your friends wisely. Never write a letter when a phone call can accomplish the same result. Never make a phone call...that someone else can make for you.

2. Determine The Purpose of Each Relationship Near You. Some have pursued you...*for something you do not have*. Identify time-wasters. Identify the parasites that only want what you have *earned*...instead of what you have *learned*.

Friendliness Is Not Friendship. You cannot be friends with everybody. *Do not feed friendships that weaken your enthusiasm for your Dream.*

3. Treasure And Protect Your Personal Health. Fatigue is an enemy to a Dream. One of the great presidents refused to make a decision after 3:00 p.m. every day. He had recognized that when he was tired, he assessed things *differently...usually wrong*.

4. Create An Environment That Feeds Your Passion For Your Dream. The happiest church office I have ever entered belongs to my dear friend in Sarasota, Florida. His office is like a museum! Children rush into his office every Sunday night...just to view the aquarium, the toys, and the many items that make you "smile." He said, "Anything that makes me laugh, I put it around me...to keep my spirits up."

Protect Your Passion.

Men Do Not Decide Their Dreams. Men Discover Their Dreams. Men Do Not Choose Their Passion. Their Passion Chooses Them.

3 Enemies of Your Passion

There will be enemies against *every goal in your life*. You must recognize them.


1. Fatigue...When you are tired, you do not see a good future. When you get tired...you start talking in a negative manner. You say the wrong things. Your words become walls instead of doors.

Your Words Are The Seeds For Feelings.

Your conversations need to amplify your Dream. Your words can easily dilute the Dream if you are talking opposite of your desired future.

God has given you a *Mouth* and a *Mind* to *magnify* your strength, to *increase* your capability.

You cannot lose weight by expressing negative statements, "I just see a menu and I start getting bigger," or "I gain weight just looking at food."

Your words should reflect your desires...reflect your confidence in your Dream. You schedule for failure with negative thoughts and words.

The Basketball Phenomenon

A Famous University did an incredible test showing the power of the mind. I studied it for two years. It is *incredible*. It is *powerful*.

Two basketball teams were selected, A and B. For 30 consecutive days, team A was instructed to practice free throws in the gym for one hour a day...for 30 days.

Team B was told to sit in the locker room, and *visualize* themselves standing at the free throw line shooting free throws. Team B was instructed to *picture the ball going through the net*. Team B was not allowed to touch the ball. They could not be on the ball court. They were allowed to see the ball *only in their mind*.

At the end of 30 days, Team A, who had been out in the gym practicing free throws 30 days, one hour a day...had increased their average by 22 percent.

Team B had not touched a ball in 30 days...*had only visualized the ball going through the net*...their percentage rose 21 percent—*almost identical* to those who had practiced with the actual basketball.

Your Mind Has Everything To Do With Your Energy, Your Focus. If satan defeats you...it will be through your mind and your words.

You win or lose...according to how you control your mind...your thoughts. "As he thinketh in his heart, so is he," (Proverbs 23:7).

What Happens Inside You Affects What Happens Around You. Stop seeing yourself as a loser, poor, broke, ignorant and unable to achieve what you desire. If that happens in your mind, every other part of your body will cooperate.

The Football Phenomenon

A phenomenal thing happened with a certain football team. An experiment was performed to discover what the effect of words would do to the mind according to what was believed.

The players were told they had been exposed to bacteria in their system...a disease. They were required to go to the hospital for tests.

In one week it was reported that two of the players were paralyzed and could not get out of bed. One had severe ringing in his ears and a variety of symptoms was evident. As they reviewed the list of players...it appeared there was *something wrong with every one of them*.

The mysterious truth was...*NOTHING was wrong with any of them.* There was no bacteria in their bodies...no disease. It was a research to discover *power of WORDS*...*the power of Suggestion...the power of VISUALIZATION.*

When **WORD-PICTURES** were planted into their minds of what could be wrong in their bodies...*the body cooperated with the mind and produced the anticipated symptoms*.

Your Own Words Are Affecting Your Self-Portrait. They give you a clear picture of the YOU in your future...*the picture God is looking at.* When God sees you, what does He say to the angels? Does He smile? What does He do? What does He say?

Say What God Says About You In His Word.

Words Are Not Cheap. "He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit. Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: and he that shutteth his lips is esteemed a man of understanding," (Proverbs 17:27-28).

Wars begin because of words. Peace comes when great men *come together, negotiate* and *dialogue.*

7 Keys About The Power of Words

1. Any Man Who Controls His Mouth Is Literally Protecting His Own Life. "He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life," (Proverbs 13:3).

2. Those Who Talk Too Much Will Eventually Be Destroyed. "He that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction," (Proverbs 13:3).

3. Right Words Can Turn An Angry Man Into A Friend, And Wrong Words Can Turn A Friend Into An Enemy. "A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger," (Proverbs 15:1).

4. Wisdom Is Necessary In Order To Speak The Right Words. "The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips," (Proverbs 16:23).

5. Your Words Reveal Whether You Are Wise or A Fool. "The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness," (Proverbs 15:2).

6. The Purpose of Words Is To Educate, Enthuse And Energize Those Around You. "The lips of the wise disperse knowledge," (Proverbs 15:7).

7. Wrong Words Create Heart Wounds That Make Trust Impossible. "The words of a talebearer are as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly," (Proverbs 18:8).

Do Not Allow Your Words To Destroy Your Dream! Jesus said your words reveal what kind of heart you possess, "For of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh," (Luke 6:45).

Favor Is When Others Desire To Bless You.

An Uncommon Dream will require an unusual amount of Favor from many different people. You must realize the importance of Favor.

15 Unforgettable Facts About Favor

1. True Favor Is A Gift From God Through People. You must recognize Favor as something you really do not deserve. Now, in the business world, talk often revolves around, "He owes me a favor."

A Favor...Is Much Different Than Favor.

A favor is an act of kindness designed to *control*, *manipulate*, or *compensate* you for something. I believe you will always resent someone you owe. Refuse relationships of indebtedness. When someone tells you that another person owes them a favor, be weary and cautious.

2. Gratitude Is A Magnet For Favor. A dear friend of mine has said many times, "What you are most thankful for will increase in your life." *When you do not value the good will and contribution of others...it will stop.*

Your Dream will require Uncommon Favor. Somebody is talking about you right now *favorably*.

3. Favor Is When Someone Creates Access Upward. There are people that The Holy Spirit is directing to give gifts to you, to bless you...to open doors that will create access for you.

4. Favor Is When Someone Prays For Your Success. *Your Dream will require Intercessors who greatly influence the flow of Favor in your life.* When you truly respect intercession, you will see the most dramatic results you have ever experienced in your lifetime.

5. Favor Is When Someone Recognizes Your Intense Efforts. Your struggles and efforts are noted. Someone is carefully evaluating your *progress, pursuits* and *potential*. The observations of Boaz birthed his marriage with Ruth (see Ruth 1-4).

6. Favor Can Begin In The Heart of Someone You Do Not Yet Know. You may not even know the person. It would astound you if you knew who is discussing you with great Favor and appreciation.

7. Favor Is Always A Reward For Faithfulness. Your consistency is attracting attention. Your ability to *stay focused* is like a magnet. Someone is observing you and considering entering your life with *favor*, *influence* and *support*. You will have access to their *skills*, *Wisdom* and circle of *friendships*.

8. Favor Overflows Around Integrity. Others are admiring your *endurance*. The observation of your *integrity* would amaze and thrill you.

9. Favor Creates Quick Success. When favor enters your life, you will achieve in a single day what would normally require a year to accomplish alone.

10. Favor Is Always Proportionate To Your Diligence. Someone is observing your productivity and attitude toward your present boss and superior.

11. An Uncommon Attitude Always Generates An Unexplainable Flow of Favor. *It happened to Ruth.* She was a *lonely, focused* and *loyal* peasant woman who was trying to find enough food to survive. *Someone noticed her.* Boaz, the wealthy landowner, came to review the Harvest. He approached Ruth after inquiring about her to his supervisors. Her humility and sweet spirit touched Boaz. He explained that he knew about her and that provision would be there as long as she wanted to reap in his field.

12. Favor Must Become Your Seed Into Others. *Every good Seed that you have sown is going to bear fruit and grow.* Every hour you have invested in restoring and healing others will produce an incredible Harvest.

13. Favor Is Always Seasonal. *Your sacrifices are not in vain.* Your toil and struggles have been *noted*, *documented* and *observed* by the Lord of the Harvest! "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not," (Galatians 6:9).

This kind of Favor always follows those who are *excited*, *focused* and *obsessed* with their Dream.

14. Favor Always Has A Divine Purpose. God goes before you. He places inside the hearts of others the desire to *aid* you, to *assist* you and *enable* you to bring your Dream to completion.

Others observe how you solve problems...how you respond to adversity and difficulty.

15. Success Increases Favor. *It happened in the life of Paul.* He was shipwrecked on the island of Melita. Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks and laid them on the fire. A snake came out of the fire and fastened onto his hand. The barbarians of the island talked among themselves. They thought, "No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live," (Acts 28:4). Nevertheless, Paul shook off the snake into the fire, and felt no harm.

That anointing for *conquering* affected those watching. Their minds were changed and said, "He must be a god!"

Overcoming talks. Others around you observe your life. Others will learn from you as they observe your life...your focus, victories and endurance.

Investors study young couples. They observe their aggressiveness and pursuit of excellence before investing.

Leaders scrutinize and note behavior of the assistants of fellow leaders.

Powerful men long for someone to trust...to work beside them daily.

Aggressive leaders search continually for others who are aggressive, energized and diligent.

Pursue excellence in your present circumstances. Whatever your Dream may be, *empty your best efforts into it.*

Do not wait for a glorious future to arrive...pursue it with enthusiasm. Your rewards will be greater than you ever dreamed.

Picture this: You are running on the track of life. The grandstands of spectators are observing you—far more than you could possibly know. "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us," (Hebrews 12:1).

Your Future Will Necessitate Change.

God reminds us through the prophet Isaiah: "Behold, *I will do a new thing*; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert," (Isaiah 43:19).

Trust The Holy Spirit to enable and empower you to change. Know why change is necessary.

Ask Mentors for advice and counsel in changes they see you should make. Be willing to take small daily steps toward change.

The Holy Spirit is the One who can initiate those changes and the people who can help you to change.

The Holy Spirit arranges people in your life to help you change...to see what you do not see...to know what you do not know.

Some changes will not happen *instantly*. It will be progressively. God does not give you all the information at one time.

The Holy Spirit Is The Agent of Change. I not only want to be changed, but, I want to be a Changer. I want someone to say to me, "You have unlocked something in me and I will never be the same...You have created a miracle in my life."

Embrace change. Be willing to move into the next season of your life. Your Uncommon Dream will require changes in your life. Are you willing to make them?

You hear it said constantly, "You cannot change anybody." I disagree. We marry to create change...friends create change.

My father brought a phenomenal truth to my attention. He said if I walk in the light that I presently have, I would receive more light...as a Divine reward.

When I see someone, who refuses to change...it is more than a *Wisdom* problem. It is also a rebellion problem.

If they were walking in the light they have, they would be receiving more light. Think on this.

Are you walking in the light that you know?

Are there changes you need to make?

Your Circumstances Are Created By Your Decisions. Your Decisions Are The Product of Your Wisdom.

I can predict your future by your willingness to change.

We read the story of Peter and Judas. They had access to the same Savior and knowledge from the same source. *One was willing to change. One was not willing to change. Peter was willing to change...Judas was not.*

Your mind requires renewing (*changing*) every day. I constantly need change. Nobody really likes the word change...yet we must be willing to change.

The unwillingness to change has consequences.

Pain...if you do not change. Pain is always the presence of loss.

Pleasure...is the product of gain...requiring change.

Pain Is The Proof of Disorder.

Change means you must do something that you are not presently doing. "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it," (Isaiah 1:19-20).

Change also means...you must stop doing something that you are comfortable doing.

Change May Cause Pain For The Present, But Gain For The Future.

The Uncommon Dream requires many changes in *Relationship*, *Habits*, *Patterns* and *Schedules*.

Not once does God assume that somebody is not capable of change. He continuously attributed lack of change to *ignorance or rebellion*. "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge," (Hosea 4:6).

Ignorance can be a source of pain. If you are willing to change...the pain can eventually be pleasure.

10 Reasons People Resist Change

1. The Change Is Not Self-Initiated. Something was not their idea. They feel like they are being manipulated. The solution is to allow others to have input and feel like they are part of the change process.

2. Routine Is Disrupted. Routine is a group-learned reaction we do

repeatedly without much thought. Change threatens our habit patterns forcing us to think and re-evaluate.

3. Change Creates Fear of The Unknown. Change means we may have to do things we have never done before. This causes our insecurities to rise.

4. The Purpose of Change May Be Unclear. We hear about the change from a second-hand source. In addition, we need an explanation, a prompt and clear understanding.

5. Change May Create A Fear of Failure. Not being sure of what lies ahead or of the unknown. People hold on to what feels comfortable.

6. Change Will Not Happen When People Engage In Negative Thinking And Behavior. You can do anything if you put your mind and focus on it.

7. Distrust of Leadership. When followers do not like the leader who oversees the changes needed, their feelings will not allow them to look at the changes objectively.

8. Feelings of Insignificance And Unworthiness. A person may feel that the change is a personal attack.

9. Change May Mean Personal Loss. Everyone ask this question when there is a change. How will this affect me? Most of the time there are 3 groups affected by change.

Those Who Lose.

Those Who Are Not Affected.

Those Who Will Benefit.

10. True Change Always Requires Additional Commitment. More of your *time*...more of your *responsibility*...more *commitment*.

Your Willingness To Change Will Determine The Reality, The Outcome And The Quality of Your Uncommon Dream.

Prayer For Inner Change. "Holy Spirit, *I want to change*. I want everything unholy in me to be uprooted. I want what is *right* to grow inside of me. I expect it in the name of Jesus. Amen."

Patience Is Mastery of The Present.

10 Facts You Should Know About Patience

1. Your Patience Is A Sign of Trust. "The Lord is good unto them that wait for Him, to the soul that seeketh Him," (Lamentations 3:25). "It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord," (Lamentations 3:26).

2. Patience Is A Seed. It is the season between sowing and reaping. That is why the Bible calls it Seed-Time and Harvest. Time is the season between the Seed and the Harvest.

3. Patience Is Often Burdensome. You may have lost the joy of your Dream because of the waiting. It breeds *agitation*, a *critical* spirit and leaves you *frustrated*.

4. Your Patience In Waiting May Be Painful. When you are *waiting*...sometimes wrong words are spoken that *abort* the cycle of blessing. You must refuse to permit words of discouragement in your mouth. "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness," (Isaiah 41:10).

5. Patience Authorizes God To Confront Your Adversaries. The Holy Spirit is involved against the enemies of your Dream. Every *scheme*, *strategy* and *trap* against you shall ultimately fail if you are patient in waiting.

6. Patience Documents Your Expectations of God. Keep your eyes on the rewards of your Patience...*the reality of your Dream...it will come to pass.* Never give up. Never quit. Overcoming involves more than one battle.

7. Patience Always Decides The Outcome. The individual that refuses to quit will win and accomplish The Uncommon Dream he desires.

8. Patience Is Continually Produced By Continuous Praise.

Unthankfulness can bring a curse, not a blessing. While you are waiting, create a climate of thanksgiving and gratitude. "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you," (1 Thessalonians 5:18).

9. Remember Patience Always Produces A Favorable Response From God. *Waiting is very difficult.*

The Holy Spirit is keenly aware of every emotional upheaval you may have at this Moment. Sometimes your pain comes from simply refusing to be patient and wait for God's timing. Our God is glorious! He is watching you. Nothing escapes His attention. For the ungodly, this may seem unsettling...that they are watched. For the person that wants the will of God...this is a delight.

10. Patience Is A Weapon.

Patience Is The Weapon That Forces Deception To Reveal Itself. It exposes hidden deceit. "For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry," (Habakkuk 2:3).

5 Keys That Develop Patience

1. Remember That Time Will Expose What Interrogation Cannot. Think of relationships in your past. Remember your first impressions? Time proved differently in many cases. First impressions are not always correct.

2. View Time As Your Friend. Permit it to work in your life and relationships. It will force facts to emerge that the greatest interrogator on earth could not expose. "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the Heaven," (Ecclesiastes 3:1).

3. Focus On The Completion of Present Tasks. There are many unfinished things around you. Complete those items while you are waiting for other information and decisions. Stay productive.

Master the art of completion. It is best to become a Finisher...rather than simply a Starter.

4. Review The Stories of Successful Champions Who Have Understood The Power of Patience. Thomas Edison experimented 5,000 times with one invention. When asked how he felt about so many failures, he replied that he had not failed, he had only "discovered something that would

not work." Absorb the success stories of others. It will affect your confidence and breathe energy and endurance into you.

5. Remind Yourself of The Losses Impatience Has Always Created. Impatience is deadly. It destroys the birth of that which is great and good. I remember reading the story of a little chick that was trying to peck its way out of its eggshell. A little farmer's daughter decided to "help it." She broke the egg open...*the chick died*.

The *patient* pecking of the little chick was developing strength for its entry into the world. The *waiting* gave it time to grow its own strength. When the little girl broke the egg...*it was too soon*.

Impatience causes you to speak too quickly, saying words that do not edify. This also grieves The Holy Spirit delaying your Dream from coming to pass.

The Uncommon Dream Will Require Uncommon Patience.



THE UNCOMMON DREAM WILL REQUIRE GOOD HEALTH AND ENERGY

Good Health Habits Generate Joy.

Mind, body and spirit need renewing...daily. Do not expect miracles to compensate for ignorance. We will stand in

line for one hour for the prayer of healing but refuse to jog for 5 minutes.

Our own decisions have often created our health problems.

You will not feel good towards God if you do not feel good about yourself. Two things did not change when you accepted Christ into your heart...your mind and your body.

Your mind needs renewing daily with The Word of God.

Your body must be disciplined daily...with exercise.

What You Do Daily Determines What You Will Do Permanently.

18 Power Thoughts About Good Health

1. Health Is More Important Than Healing. Some ministers have not yet seen the value of encouraging their congregations to pursue good health habits.

2. Your Body Is A Divine Gift; Your Care of It Is Proof of Gratitude. We are responsible to take care of what God has given us. It is a challenge. *It will always be a challenge...but a worthy goal.*

3. Any Action Toward Health Generates Joy. Every day you move toward health, you will increase your joy and your peace. *When there is joy and peace...* there is *motivation* and *focus* to follow the steps to your Dream.

4. Buy The Wisdom of A Fitness Trainer. *Weights can be used daily*. When possible...secure a trainer to get you started. They will know exactly what you need for your body type and motivate you as no one else can.

Find a *personal trainer* who knows how to help you get to where you want to go in the shortest amount of time.

Remind yourself of the advantages and benefits of strength and having a strong body. Learn the secrets about weight lifting...and strength training.

Subscribe to weight lifting magazines that help you *visualize* your future success and the changes in your body.

5. Schedule Your Morning Health Hour. Workout...*personalize your own physical workout.* When I have been traveling for hours...I do not feel like exercising when I get home...but the rewards are worth it when I do.

Watch videos while you work out. Watch the results of your life and your body as you will begin to see changes if you are consistent.

6. Place Visual Pictures Around You That Birth Motivation And Expectation.

Expect *patiently instead of grumbling and whining when you do not see immediate results.*

Expect God to do His supernatural part in responding to your pursuit for health.

Expect your body to make the necessary changes. You did not get where you are instantly and you will not regain what you want instantly.

7. Walk One Mile A Day. Walking...20 minutes to an hour a day can revolutionize your life...your emotions...your focus. Walk...tall like a champion with your shoulders back.

Walk...with a picture of health in your mind. Walk...expecting radical improvement. Walk...tall like a weight-lifter or Olympic champion. Keep this picture in your mind.

Walk...with imagination, as if you are in a contest and you are ahead of everyone else. Walk...with a purpose and goal in your mind...for instance, take this time to memorize a Scripture or listen to a one-hour teaching tape as you walk.

Listen to Scriptures with your headphones. Walking is the best exercise to radically, positively affect your mood swings...*the way you think*.

Walking prevents lower back pain. The benefits of a good walking routine are too numerous to mention in this chapter.

Become conscious of your time. Remember you are sowing into your whole future...*perfect health*.

Watch losers deteriorate before your eyes because they took their health lightly or for granted. They *used to be* champions.

Maybe as you read this, you are saying, "It is too late for me!"

No! It is not too late! You can begin again and still be *a Winner...a Champion*.

Read these chapters again...begin to apply personal changes. New

results will soon be yours.

*Pursue with diligence to develop a body that pleases God...*one of good health and energy. At the same time, your new health habits will aid you in accomplishing your Dream. *Good Health Takes Time With Consistent Good Habits.*

8. Pursue Health Habits Openly And Aggressively. Be ruthless in asserting your posture and purpose in *developing* good health. *Note that when you discuss losing weight, that is when they offer you donuts!*

9. Everything In Your Life Is A Habit. What new *health habit* will benefit your Dream?

10. Change Your Health One Day At A Time. *What is one thing you can change today toward your new healthy lifestyle?* Develop the habit of health consciousness. You do not have to have a handful of keys to start your car...*just one.*

11. Romance Your Body Through Self-Talk. Positive Self-Talk *will encourage you when no one else can.* Look at your body and say, "You are a gift from God to me. I am going to do my best to protect your *heart...your mind* and *increase your strength* by what I say and do. I am going to take care of you."

Talk to yourself. Talk good health options to others. What you talk about will increase in your life. You will move towards anything you discuss often. Begin today.

12. Surround Yourself With Healthy Foods. *Weigh yourself on accurate scales.* Weigh honestly and admit the truth to yourself. Weigh with a *weight loss goal* in mind.

Remember within you is the persistence and perseverance to win. Plan your daily diet on only those things that build your strength and energy.

13. Depression Rarely Occurs In Healthy Bodies. One doctor who has treated more people, more depression than any other doctor on earth has said, "I have never treated anyone with depression who was *physically* fit."

14. Good Habits Can Replace Bad Habits. God gave us one body. It is our responsibility to take care of it. We must! *One bad habit* can mess up your life. *One good habit* can turn your life around.

15. Find What Motivates You Toward Good Health. You must do all you can to regain the best quality of physical and mental health possible for you.

16. Small Changes Birth Great Rewards. It does not have to be

radical changes...small ones done *consistently* will encourage you.

throughout the famine (see 1 Kings 17).

15. Dependability Is The Seed For Promotion. If you sow the Seed of *diligence* on your job, the Harvest will be a *promotion*. "The soul of the sluggard desireth, and hath nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat," (Proverbs 13:4). "He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich," (Proverbs 10:4).

16. Whatever You Are, You Will Create Around You. I am Irish. What will I create? *Irishmen*. What will a German create? *Germans*. What will a watermelon seed create? *Watermelons*. When you become generous with others, people around you desire to give to you. It is *simple, explosive and undeniable*.

17. Your Seed Is Guaranteed A 100-Fold Return. Jesus taught the 100-fold principle. "And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for My sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life," (Mark 10:29-30).

Every Season Contains A Season of Testing. Everything in your life is a reward or a test.

Your Dream Is The Picture God Gave You To Keep You Motivated. Rewards are used to motivate the entire earth. God planned it that way. It is unnatural to pursue decrease. It is normal to pursue increase. This desire for gain is not satanic. Adam and Eve contained a desire for increase before they ever fell into sin. *The first command given to every living creature was to multiply*. You have the nature of God within you. The desire to grow is from Him.

13 Facts You Should Remember During A Season of Testing

1. The Holy Spirit Will Guide You Into A Time of Testing. "And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, Being forty days tempted of the devil," (Luke 4:1-2).

You Must Qualify For The Uncommon Dream. The Holy Spirit will test you to qualify you for the promotion of The Uncommon Dream for which you have been striving. *The purpose of the testing is not mere survival*. It is to qualify you for the promotion...the increase of rewards.

2. The Uncommon Dream Is Always Tested By Unexpected Loss. *The desire for multiplication and increase is a characteristic of God.* "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly," (John 10:10).

7. Your Knowledge of Scriptures Decides Your Strength In Times of Testing. When Jesus was being tempted, He did not cry out for special music so He could access the right frame of mind, or His most resourceful state.

He never said, "I must get back to the synagogue. I had no business coming out here alone." No, Jesus *knew* the answers.

As Jesus began to quote the eternal Word of God, satan became *demoralized* and *paralyzed*. Jesus passed the test...the Anointing began to flow.

8. Expect Your Enemy To Make Unexpected Mistakes. Your enemy always makes mistakes. *Your only responsibility is to trust The Holy Spirit.*

"Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy," (James 5:11). One Cannot Multiply.

You Can Succeed Significantly In Your Life. You Can Have Incredible Relationships. You Can Produce Finances Beyond Your Wildest Dreams. *However, you will never do it alone.*

Life is a collection of relationships and those relationships compensate for what you do not have.

Imitate Your Master Mentor, Jesus.

Jesus *commanded* the multitudes.

He *instructed* His disciples to have the people sit down.

He distributed the loaves and fishes to His disciples for distribution.

Jesus gave instructions to a blind man to complete his healing. "When he had thus spoken, He spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing," (John 9:6-7). Jesus sent His disciples into cities to prepare for special meals. (See Mark 14:12-15.)

7 Keys To Delegation And Networking

1. Acknowledge Your Own Limitations To Achieve Your Dream. When you do...unexplainable energy ignites inside you. Admitting your own limitations actually frees your mind to pursue the remedy and motivate others to assist you.

Anything You Do Not Have Is Stored In Someone Near You, And Love Is The Secret Map To The Treasure. It is an internal integrity to admit your need for others.

2. Make A Checklist of Their Specific Responsibilities. Avoid verbal instructions. Provide a written list of tasks to be accomplished.

3. Clarify Your Expectations of Your Team. Confusion paralyzes. It neutralizes the flow of energy.

4. Provide Information And Authority Necessary To Complete Those Tasks. Inform others regarding the chain of authority. Identify openly who is authorized to instruct and who is expected to obey.

5. Establish Agreeable Deadlines To Complete The Tasks And Projects. Written plans unlock confidence in time lines and projected dates of completion.

6. Invest Time In Collaborative Conversation. This will bring others into harmony.

7. Remind Them of Their Rewards For Their Efforts. Always reward those who solve problems for you. Make the time to motivate and educate them as to your exact expectations. *Take the time to delegate. Jesus delegated.* Your Dream may require extraordinary negotiations.

The Secret of Sam Walton

Sam Walton was a great negotiator. When he wanted to create the number one store in America, he went to his vendors. He negotiated with the owners of major companies for lower prices on their products. He told them his plan and said, "I will need your cooperation." He insisted, fought, and negotiated every inch of the way. He wanted to give his customers the best prices in America. He required the same from the manufacturers of his products.

Sam Walton knew the golden secrets necessary to make his own dreams come true. *He negotiated until he secured their cooperation*. Their companies received tremendous profits. You must nurture and protect those relationships connected to your Dream.

The Secret of Dexter Yager

Dexter Yager is one of the most Uncommon men I know. I urge you to read his book, *Don't Let Anybody Steal Your Dream*. Dexter writes, "*The successful person associates with those who support his Dream*."

The Secret of Solomon

Solomon knew you can never achieve a significant Dream without the involvement of people. He saw the hidden treasures in others around him in a way no one had seen before. He regarded the people around him as more than servants and employees. He saw them as more than sources of revenues and taxes.

His love was deep enough to ask God for uncommon ability to bless and strengthen those he governed. "Give therefore Thy servant an understanding heart to judge Thy people that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this Thy so great a people?" (1 Kings 3:9).

Love people enough to empty your life into them.

Love people enough to pursue ways to reward them.

Love people enough to discern the dominant gift God has deposited in you for them.

Within every human heart, beats a fervent desire to be needed, desired and celebrated. Recognize their differences and become their "bridge to greatness."

Solomon knew the principle and power of internal integrity. Denying his weakness would have paralyzed him. Now, he has an antenna, attracting *information, aid* and *encouragement* from others. You see, it is in the nature of man to help another. It is normal and natural...a trait God placed within us. When you try to do everything yourself, you prevent others from moving toward you. They feel *unnecessary, insignificant* and *unimportant* and you lose the "gold mine" placed within them.

The Uncommon Dream will always require the observation of others. Talk to those close to you. *Do not hesitate to ask them to tell you what they are seeing, hearing and discovering.*

The Secret of Steven K. Scott

As you pursue the dreams and goals for your life, take a sheet of paper and do what one of America's wealthiest men has suggested. Steven K. Scott, co-founder of the American Telecast Corporation, said in his book, A *Millionaire's Notebook*, "*List what you consider your greatest weakness*, both personally and professionally—lack of education, lack of career achievement, impatience, short temper, etc."

When you do this...you acknowledge your weaknesses and *attract those* who are able to help you overcome them.

Pursue The Secrets of Others

Invest Time In Learning The Secret of Others' Successes. Someone close to you contains answers.

Who has done what you want to do?

Who has had remarkable success?

Schedule appointments with them. Ask them to tell you what important questions you should ask.

Protocol Matters. Conduct yourself wisely in the presence of greatness. How you conduct yourself may determine whether you ever receive a second invitation. *Every Environment Requires A Code of Conduct For Entering or Remaining In It.*

The Uncommon Dream Will Require Adaptation To The Needs of Those Around You. Never underestimate the importance of people. We live in a busy, hurried world. It is easy to be caught in the whirlwind of tasks and goals.

The Master Key to achieving The Uncommon Dream is inspiring those around you to become involved in its completion through network, collaboration and negotiation.

4 Qualities of Wise Associations

1. Those Who Speak Words That Increase Your Faith And Wisdom. Become more selective in your friendships. Remember: The same time you waste on losers can be invested in winners.

2. Those Who See The Worthiness of Your God-Given Dream. Listen for Wisdom around you. "If any of you lack Wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given

him," (James 1:5).

3. Those Who Become Enthusiastic When You Enter Their Presence. If you give time to those unworthy of it, *stop complaining*. You are the one who gave them the time. They abused it because you allowed them the opportunity.

4. Those Who Remind You of Your Special Gifts And Abilities. Winners are people who have discovered their special talents, abilities, and special God-given gifts.

You can change the course of your life. A newcomer to town may fail to notice a traffic light and a collision results. Knowing the "Stop and Go" lights of life determine your tears or triumphs. The Willingness To Reach Births The Ability To Change.

Wisdom Is The Ability To Discern.

Discerning Right People And Wrong People. Good Decisions From Bad Decisions.

I love to see people succeed with their lives. It is also the desire of God, the Creator. As the artist treasures his painting, and the master craftsman the quality of the violin he created, so our Maker cherishes the *dreams, goals, excellence of life and the happiness you and I are to enjoy.*

Two Forces Are Vital To Happiness: your relationships and your achievements or dreams.

The Gospel Has Two Forces: The Person of Jesus Christ and the Principles that He taught.

- One Is The **Son of God**; The Other Is The **System of God**.
- One Is The Life of God; The Other Is The Law of God.
- One Is **The King**; The Other Is **The Kingdom**.
- One Is **An Experience With God**; The Other Is **The Expertise of God**.
- One Is **Heart-Related**; The Other Is **Mind-Related**.

Salvation is experienced...instantaneously. Principles are learned...progressively.

Both Forces Are Absolute Essentials To Total Success And Happiness.

It is important that you have a Dream or purpose in your life. Joseph dreamed a Dream.

Jesus had a purpose. Your dreams should be ordered of the Lord. "The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and He delighteth in his way," (Psalm 37:23).

David wanted to build the temple, but his desire was not a God-intended goal. Solomon was the builder God had chosen.

You *discover* God's plans. *Usually, God's plans are revealed step-bystep.* If your Dream or desires persist, it probably is an indication that God wants you involved in that particular accomplishment. For example, God chose Solomon to build the temple, but David chose the materials.

You Must Know What God Wants You To Do Before You Can Do It. Be prepared by doing the following:

Look for Signs.

Listen to The Spirit.

Develop "Instant Response" to The Voice of God.

Eliminate the Time-Wasters in your life.

Concentrate on your God-Connections.

Understanding and Wisdom are the Golden Keys to mastering any situation in life.

The Word of God Is The Wisdom of God. "The entrance of Thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple," (Psalm 119:130).

Wisdom Is Seeing What God Sees.

Wisdom Is The Golden Key To Achieving The Uncommon Dream. Knowledge is exploding all around us. Uncommon men of God are sharing their expertise and teaching us principles to change every area of our lives.

Your Uncommon Dream Will Require Uncommon Wisdom.

Two Sources of Knowledge

1. Mentors—Learning From The Mistakes of Others.

2. Mistakes—Learning From Your Own Mistakes.

If you are unhappy with yourself, dare to reach for new *information*, new *teaching* and new *truths* that will elevate you and build your relationship with God.

If there is a sin in your life, repent and rededicate your life to Jesus Christ. Allow His precious blood to cleanse you. He will restore the fellowship you need with Him.

12 Wisdom Principles That Will Bring You Closer To Your Uncommon Dream

1. Never Speak Words That Make Satan Think He Is Winning. Your words are life. Express hope and confidence in God. Get so excited over planning your triumphs, you do not have time to complain over past losses.

2. Life Changes Only When Your Daily Priorities Change. Organize your time. Chart a detailed course with established deadlines. Set established time-sensitive goals. *When You Plan Your Day, You Have Planned Your Life.*

3. Those Who Do Not Respect Your Time Will Not Respect Your Wisdom. Cultivate discernment of people. Develop the ability to listen to God in the role someone has in your life.

4. Stop Looking At What You See And Start Looking At What You Can Have. Rebuild a good self-portrait. Sometimes we become more problem-oriented than possibility-oriented. Be thankful for the gifts God has given you. Concentrate on your strong points.

5. Intolerance of The Present Creates A Future. Dare to embrace change. You are what you have decided to be. *Never Complain About What You Permit.*

6. Whoever Cannot Increase You Will Eventually Decrease You. Disconnect from unqualified persons who abuse and misuse your life. Reevaluate your friendships. Do not allow your Dream to be destroyed because of someone who laughs at your pursuit of accomplishment.

9. Failure Will Last Only As Long As You Permit It. Realize that God is with you all the time. Depend on His presence to uphold you and keep you strong. You can become free when you "Practice" the presence of God.

10. Men Do Not Really Decide Their Future...They Decide Their Habits—Then, Their Habits Decide Their Future. Control the circumstances within your power. Decide what you can change. Start developing habits that will affect your future Dreams and goals.

11. You Will Never Leave Where You Are Until You Decide Where You Would Rather Be. It is normal to experience a few setbacks, moments of doubt and confusion. Make this your confession. "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me," (Philippians 4:13).

12. The Seasons of Your Life Will Change Every Time You Decide To Use Your Faith. Remember...

God made you to soar...*not sink!* God made you to fly...*not fall!* God made you to stand...*not stumble!*

14 Power Keys For Managing Your Mind

1. Discern The True Definition of Success. Success is the progressive achievement of a God-given goal.

2. Set Definite Goals For Yourself. You do not merely set your goals, but set them under Divine guidance.

3. Make Your Goals Balanced And Reasonable. Over-emphasis in one area will cause another area to deteriorate. "The Wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way," (Proverbs 14:8).

4. Meditate In Scripture. The mentality of God is absorbed through simply reading The Word of God. It gives you discerning ability for what is false and what is true.

5. Discern The Spiritual Mentor That Most Increases Your Confidence In The Word of God. Invest time in finding the right church and then be loyal. Attend consistently. Volunteer your time as a Seed and God will honor you greatly.

6. Schedule Time With Uncommon Achievers. Be a learner. "He that walketh with wise men shall be wise," (Proverbs 13:20).

7. Invest In Yourself. Develop your *mind*, *spirit* and *inner* man. If a \$20 meal makes your stomach feel good for 4 hours, think what it could do to your mentality and power-life to invest \$20 in tapes or books that soak your mind and spirit in the anointing of God.

8. Stay Steadily Productive And In Movement. Time-wasters grieve God. Idleness results in *frustration*, *boredom* and possibly even *depression*.

9. Identify Your Dominant Distinction From Others And Build Your Thought Life Around It. Take a good look at yourself. You are accountable to God for developing your skills. *Everyone's talents and gifts differ*.

Though a man is compensated by other men according to their need for his special gifts, God values every man's abilities and gifts equally. You must do the same. *Value the greatness of your gifts*. Invest time to improve them. The special talents God has given to you will generate everything you will need to be financially successful, but *you must grow the Seeds within you*.

10. You Must Cultivate A Teachable Spirit. Willingness to change is not necessarily a compromise of principles.

11. Unwrap Your Present Moments And Savor The Divine Difference You Discern In Them. Every Moment you want to feel in your future is already in your present. It took you a lifetime to get to this Moment...why are you racing from it?

12. Remind Yourself That Something God Has Hidden Within You Is Keeping Him Very Interested In His Investment. You feel like an acorn. God is looking at the oak tree you are becoming. *The Greatest Success Quality On Earth Is The Willingness To Become.*

13. Sowing The Seed of Adaptation Is Proof of Genius. *Flexibility* and *openness* to truth are evidence you are a winner. Sometimes it takes courage to listen. Time and knowledge should enlarge you. Let it change you.

Do not be a "know it all." *The First Step Toward Success Is The Willingness To Listen.*

14. Use Your Mouth To Master Your Mind. You become what you think.

Picture Yourself In Health. Picture Yourself In Prosperity. Picture Yourself In A Happy Marriage. Picture Yourself As An Overcomer. Picture Yourself As Victorious.

When you control your thoughts, you control your life. "Whatsoever things are true...honest...just...pure...lovely...of good report; if there be any virtue, if there be any praise, think on these things," (Philippians 4:8). Visualize what you want to materialize.

Obedience Is Completing An Instruction.

Obedience Is The Only Thing God Has Ever Required of Man. "If ye love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever," (John 14:15-16).

15 Power Thoughts On Obedience

1. Your Obedience Always Brings Pleasure To God. "Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool," (Isaiah 1:17-18).

2. The Obedient Are Promised Prosperity. "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it," (Isaiah 1:19-20).

3. The Obedient Are The Only Ones Who Qualify For Blessings. "But He said, Yea, rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it," (Luke 11:28).

4. The Obedient Are Guaranteed Safety. *Obedience to The Word guarantees your personal safety.* "Wherefore ye shall do My statutes, and keep My judgments, and do them; and ye shall dwell in the land in safety," (Leviticus 25:18).

5. The Obedient Affects The Destiny of Many Generations In Their Own Families. "And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed My voice," (Genesis 22:18).

6. The Obedient Document Their Trust In God. Obedience is the only proof of your faith in God. You asked God for a miracle. He gives you an instruction. When you obey the instruction, it is proof that you believe what

He said.

7. The Obedient Learn What Others Never Do. "Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered; And being made perfect, He became the Author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him," (Hebrews 5:8-9).

8. The Obedient Qualify For A Personal Relationship With God. Obedience creates your relationship with God. "And He answered and said unto them, My mother and My brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it," (Luke 8:21).

As Christians, we need to *implement, embrace* and *build* on the knowledge of properly following instructions.

Ask The Holy Spirit to wake up a desire in you to follow His instructions. He desires obedience from His children above all.

Obedience always creates waves of blessing.

Obedience To The Counsel of Your Spiritual Mentor. To follow your Uncommon Dream...there will be times that you will receive instructions from someone in an advisory position. It could be your pastor or a mentor you have chosen to lead you.

Simple obedience will be the path to pursue. Even when you do not understand something...you have to trust. Their decisions are not always logical but on a supernatural revelation from God.

I can trace most of the pain in my life to an ignored instruction...an act of disobedience.

You cannot build a *future*...a *vision*...an *Uncommon Dream* if there is not enough respect to follow someone's instructions.

9. Your Reaction To A Man of God Determines God's Reaction To You.

Your reaction to His authority is your way of *honoring* or *dishonoring* Him. *What are you doing with the instructions God has already given you?* What are you doing with the instructions of your supervisor?

10. You Can Only Be Promoted By Someone Whose Instructions You Have Followed. Follow the instructions of the authority over you. Also, expect your employees to follow your instructions.

Ask The Holy Spirit to give you understanding about how *obedience* produces *rewards*. *The Instruction You Follow Determines The Future You Create*.

11. Obedience Produces Victories. Achan was a man in the Bible who

did not follow an instruction and there was weeping in every tent in Israel because of his disobedience.

12. God Will Never Advance You Beyond Your Last Act of Disobedience.

13. Obedience May Create A Temporary Season of Loss. Obedience is rarely easy. Some losses are unavoidable. However, those losses are necessary and essential for long-term gains.

God has reasons for every demand He makes on your life. You must see Treasures beyond your Losses.

The Double Portion Blessing of God Can Follow Every Major Loss. It happened when Job lost his children, his flocks and herds, and his position of credibility and popularity. "And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before," (Job 42:10-12).

14. There Is No More Disrespect That Can Be Shown Than To Ignore or Refuse To Follow An Instruction Given. You are never responsible for the pain of those who ignore your counsel.

15. Obedience Increases Your Worth. *When a dog is obedient, its worth soars.* There are schools of obedience for dogs that are very costly. It also increases the price of the dog.

Many animals learn obedience for circus routines to perform at zoos. Men make fortunes from obedient animals.

10 Master Keys To Following Instructions

1. Never Treat An Instruction Lightly.

- An instruction should be clear, precise and understandable.
- Instructions move any project toward completion.
- *Instructions are to lighten the load.*
- *Instructions are explicit to avoid waste of money.*

2. Instructions Must Come From The One Authorized And Qualified To Give It.

• *Must be thorough and complete...*

- Must be spoken clearly...
- Must be understood...
- Must be given to the one responsible for its completion...
- Must have time definition...

3. Listen To The Instruction Completely.

- Listen to details...
- Schedules expected...
- Problems anticipated...
- Color...Size...
- Qualities...Quantities...
- Note what was not said so you can ask appropriate questions.

4. Repeat Back The Instructions.

- The person giving the instruction...needs to hear exactly what you heard.
- Sometimes something was thought but...not really spoken.
- The employee sometimes hears only a part of an instruction.
- Sometimes both assume the other knows what they are thinking and discussing.
- Say it back clearly...completely.

5. Complete The Instruction.

- Do it the way it was expected.
- *Do it completely and thoroughly.*
- *Report any problems you may encounter.*

6. Report To The Person Who Gave You The Instruction.

- Report progress and status as it continues.
- *Report it continuously.*
- *Report it back honestly.*

When an instruction is ignored—the very opposite has occurred. *Any ignored instruction will create a loss of time energy or money*.

7. Never Trivialize An Instruction.

- Do not play it down. "I know pastor said he wanted that, but you know sometimes he changes his mind."
- Disrespect is evident by unkind remarks.

8. Prevent "Forgotten Instructions."

- Write it down. A short pencil is longer than a long memory.
- Use a Day Timer to keep track of instructions and important information.
- Use your mind for creativity not memory.

9. Do Not Alter Instructions.

- Gain an understanding of what is being said and then write it down.
- Then repeat back to your instructor what you understood them to say.

10. Do Not Neglect An Instruction.

• Do not challenge an instruction. If you have something to say about it...call your leader aside and clarify or ask for more information.

Authority Is Not Permission To Dominate.

Authority is permission to protect. The purpose of authority is not merely to restrict, but rather to advance another, to recognize and reward their obedience. Authority requires qualification.

3 Rewards For Submitting To Legitimate Authority

Those Who Rule Over You Are Instructed To Reward You. "Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in thine hand to do it," (Proverbs 3:27).

1. Qualified Authority Should Offer Protection To You. Note that God did not simply instruct you to bring the tithe to Him. He promised to protect everything you create and generate.

The covenant rewards everyone involved.

2. Qualified Authority Should Produce Provision For You. That is exactly what God promises you. "If thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth," (Deuteronomy 28:1).

3. Qualified Authority Should Promote You. The true source of promotion comes from God. "For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge: He putteth down one, and setteth up another," (Psalm 75:6-7).

16 Facts You Should Know About Submission

1. Your Submission Is The Willingness To Embrace The Leadership of Those Responsible For Governing Your Life. Submission is rewarded when it is followed according to The Word of God. There will be many different seasons in discovering your Dream.

2. Your Submission Is A Personal Choice. "God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord and He shall lift you up," (James 4:6, 10).

3. Your Submission Reveals Humility. Some people assume that leadership is strength and submission implies weakness. However, true submission is evidence of flexibility, trust and humility. It is the quality of champions. Humility is the gate to promotion.

4. Your Submission Is Your Personal Gift of Cooperation To Those Who Govern You. Every great leader began as a great follower. They honored authority established by God. "Obey them that have rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you," (Hebrews 13:17).

5. Your Submission To Authority Reflects The Nature of Jesus Within You. When Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, He prayed this prayer before Calvary. "O My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me: nevertheless not as I will, but as Thou wilt," (Matthew 26:39).

6. Your Submission Should Eventually Result In Inner Joy. "Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God," (Hebrews 12:2).

7. Your Submission To A Mentor Qualifies You For His Anointing. Elisha received a double portion of Elijah's anointing as a reward.

8. Your Refusal To Submit To The Chain of Authority Will Schedule Seasons of Tragedy. "But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it," (Isaiah 1:20).

9. Your Submission To A True Man-Woman of God Will Produce Prosperity. "Believe in the Lord your God, so shall ye be established; believe His prophets, so shall ye prosper," (2 Chronicles 20:20).

10. Your Submission To A Wise And Qualified Spiritual Leadership Is A Scriptural Command. "Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the Word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation," (Hebrews 13:7).

11. Your Submission In Honoring And Respecting Others Reveals Your Fear of God. "Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God," (Ephesians 5:21). "Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of Heaven," (Matthew 18:4).

12. Your Submission Reveals The Fear of God And Guarantees Supernatural Provision And Promotion. "By humility and the fear of the Lord are riches, and honor, and life," (Proverbs 22:4).

13. Your Submission To Authority Is Often Reproduced In Those Who Serve You. *What you are, you will create around you.* When you submit to those over you, it motivates those under your rule to submit to you as well. You become their example. *Those who govern you are also under the authority of God.*

14. Your Submission To The Word of God Will Unleash Uncommon Wisdom Within You. The Scriptures are able, "...to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus...That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works," (2 Timothy 3:15-17).

15. Your Submission Is A Seed That Eventually Results In The Harvest of Honor. Do not be weary, when you feel stressed, overwhelmed and incapable of meeting the requirements of others. "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season ye shall reap, if we faint not," (Galatians 6:9).

16. Your Submission Is The Divine Link To A Person Who Observes, Respects And Elevates You Into Your Uncommon Dream. God often uses someone in authority over you to advance your Assignment to help discover your Uncommon Dream.

- Ruth *submitted* to Naomi who linked her to Boaz.
- Naaman *submitted* to the prophet and his leprosy disappeared.
- The widow of Zarephath *submitted* to The Seed instruction of Elijah and reaped a Harvest in the midst of famine.

The Uncommon Dream Will Require Submission To Someone.

THE UNCOMMON DREAM WILL REQUIRE THE HEART OF A WARRIOR

Warfare Is Inevitable.

Your Enemy Observes All Progress.

The Holy Spirit is your Mentor for seasons of battle and warfare, "He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms," (Psalm 18:34). "Blessed be the Lord my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight," (Psalm 144:1).

Completion of your *Assignment* will cause the completion of your *Dream*. It will also require the *Nature, Skills and Mentality of a Warrior*.

18 Qualities of The Uncommon Warrior

1. The Uncommon Warrior Only Uses The Weapons That Have Never Failed Him. David refused to use the weapons. David used the weapon he was most familiar with—his sling. (See 1 Samuel 17:38-40.)

2. The Uncommon Warrior Refuses To Use The Armor And Weaponry of Others Who Had Failed Before Him. David did. "And Saul armed David with his armor, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head: also he armed him with a coat of mail. And David girded his sword upon his armor, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved it. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved them. And David put them off him," (1 Samuel 17:38-39).

3. The Uncommon Warrior Knows He Has Something His Enemy Should Fear. David had a willingness to fight. "And David said to Saul, Let not man's heart fail because of him; thy servant will go and fight with this Philistine," (1 Samuel 17:32).

4. The Uncommon Warrior Knows The True Source of His Competence And Confidence. David did. "David said moreover, The Lord that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, He will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine," (1 Samuel 17:37).

5. The Uncommon Warrior Knows That The Power of God Is

Greater Than The Weapons of Man. David did. "Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied," (1 Samuel 17:45).

6. The Uncommon Warrior Often Uses, In His Greatest Battle, The Skills Developed In His Daily Routine. David did. He was accustomed to protecting the sheep of his father. "And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling was in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine," (1 Samuel 17:40).

7. The Uncommon Warrior Expects To Be An Instrument In The Hand of God To Destroy His Enemy. David did. He said, "And I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcases of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel," (1 Samuel 17:46).

8. The Uncommon Warrior Expects His Enemies To Fall And He Publicly Predicts His Victory. David did. "This day will the Lord deliver thee into mine hand," (1 Samuel 17:46). "When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at Thy presence," (Psalm 9:3).

9. The Uncommon Warrior Stays On The Offensive Running Toward His Enemies. David did. "And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine," (1 Samuel 17:48).

10. The Uncommon Warrior Expects The Spectators of The Battle **To Observe And Experience The Power of God.** David did. "And all this assembly shall know that the Lord saveth not with sword and spear: for the battle is the Lord's, and He will give you into our hands," (1 Samuel 17:47).

11. The Uncommon Warrior Keeps Vibrant Memories of Past Victories. David did. "And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock: And I went out after him, and smote him, and delivered it out of his mouth: and when he arose against me, I caught him by his beard, and smote him, and slew him. Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God," (1 Samuel 17:34-36).

12. The Uncommon Warrior Ignores The Opinions of Obvious

Losers And Failures Around Him. David did. "And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle. And David said, What have I now done? Is there not a cause? And he turned from him toward another, and spake after the same manner: and the people answered him again after the former manner," (1 Samuel 17:28-30).

13. The Uncommon Warrior Pursues, Savors And Celebrates The Rewards of Every Victory. David did. "And the men of Israel said, Have ye seen this man that is come up? surely to defy Israel is he come up: and it shall be, that the man who killeth him, the king will enrich him with great riches, and will give him his daughter, and make his father's house free in Israel. And David spake to the men that stood by him, saying, What shall be done to the man that killeth this Philistine, and taketh away the reproach from Israel? for who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?" (1 Samuel 17:25-26).

14. The Uncommon Warrior Keeps His Promise To Destroy His Enemy. David did. "Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith," (1 Samuel 17:51).

15. The Uncommon Warrior Unashamedly Displays The Spoils of Past Victories As Trophies of Thanksgiving. David did. David even carried the head of Goliath around with him. "And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand," (1 Samuel 17:57).

16. The Uncommon Warrior Creates His Own Museum of Memories To Celebrate His Victories. David did. "And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armor in his tent," (1 Samuel 17:54).

17. The Uncommon Warrior Knows That The Defeat of His Strongest Adversary Will Cause His Other Enemies To Flee. David saw this. When Goliath fell, his followers fled. "And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled," (1 Samuel 17:51).

18. The Uncommon Warrior Knows That When He Is Victorious, The Discouraged Around Him Become Encouraged And Energized. David saw this happen. "And the men of Israel and Judah arose, and shouted, and pursued the Philistines, until thou come unto the valley, and to the gates of Ekron. And the wounded of the Philistines fell down by the way to Shaaraim, even unto Gath, and unto Ekron," (1 Samuel 17:52).
