

MEASURING GOD'S TIMELINE

This generation is facing a transition into a new millennium. There have only been five times in human history that any generation ever faced a new millennium. We're not only facing a new millennium, but the last millennium before eternity. There are only seven millenniums mentioned in the Bible. We are approaching the end of the sixth millennium, and most Bible scholars agree that the seventh millennium is the Millennial Reign of Christ of 1000 years of peace and righteous rule. During that time frame, Satan will be bound and cast into the bottomless pit. It is referred to in the Scriptures as a rest for the people of God.

In Hebrews 4:3, Paul said,

For we which have believed

do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the 3

foundation of the world. For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

It is evident that the Apostle Paul is referring to the Genesis account, for this is where the timeline begins.

THREE SCRIPTURAL KEYS TO END-TIME REVELATION

There are three keys that give us great insight into understanding the sequence and timing of end-time events. Key number one is found in Isaiah

46:10 which basically says that God spoke the end from the beginning. Key number two is found in II Peter 3:8, "... one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." Then key number three is found in Ecclesiastes 1:9-10, "The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done..." These three keys give us vital information which releases revelation concerning God's timeline for end-time events.

MAN IN GOD'S IMAGE

Genesis chapter one reveals that, at the end of the sixth day of creation, man was in the image and likeness of God. The Scripture states that God had finished His work at the end of six days. The seventh day was called a day of rest because He had finished His work. This is a basic blueprint of God's dealing with mankind. The six days of creation were twenty-four hour days, but they represent 6000 years of human history in which God will have finished His first stage of dealing with mankind. This will bring about some major changes here on Earth.

Genesis 6:3 would seem to confirm that the six days of the Genesis account represent 6000 years in which God will have finished His first stage of dealing with mankind and creation.

The Lord said, "... My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years." Jesus

said that as it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be in the days of the coming of the Son of Man.

As Noah warned the wicked of the
Earth for 120 natural years of the
coming judgment of the flood, it seems
there will be 120 Jubilee years before
the second judgment comes upon planet
Earth.

EVERY 50TH YEAR—A JUBILEE

After Israel came out of Egypt, we find in Leviticus 25 that God said every fiftieth year was to be a year of Jubilee. It was a year when all debts were canceled and all the servants went free. This seems to be prophetic of what will happen after 120 Jubilees confirming the timeline of 6000 years revealed in

"A day is with the Lord as a thousand years, a thousand years as a day," reveals that after 6000 years there will be major changes as we transition into the seventh millennium.

THE DAYS OF NOAH

Then key number three—"The thing that hath been, is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done..." would

seem to confirm that after 120 Jubilees
the judgment of God will be poured out
upon planet Earth ... similar to what
happened in the days of Noah, in other
words, a flood of judgment. The things
that happened in days past and were
recorded in the Scriptures, profile what

will happen in the future.

MOSES CALLED UP IN A CLOUD AFTER SIX DAYS

In Exodus 24, we find another significant confirmation of a 6000-year timeline. The glory of the Lord abode on Mount Sinai and a cloud covered it for six days. Then after six days, God called Moses up in the cloud. I believe this event portrays what will happen sometime after the 6000 years have expired.

Moses, the man of God who lived exactly 120 years, was a living profile of the Earth lease period of 120 Jubilees. He represents all of the righteous who will live on planet Earth in the 120 Jubilees of the Earth lease period and die before they enter into the Promised Land. Their bodies will not be

found in the Earth, but will rise first at the time of the Rapture.

Paul said in I Thessalonians 4:15-16:

For this we say unto you by
the word of the Lord, that we
which are alive and remain unto
the coming of the Lord shall not
prevent them which are asleep.

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first.

The profile found in Exodus 24 seems to confirm the resurrection of all the righteous dead after six days which represents 6000 years. Just how far after 6000 years we don't

exactly know, but we can get close as we stay with the Word of God.

BE READY—THE THIRD DAY

We find a major clue in Exodus 19:10-11,

And the LORD said unto
Moses, Go unto the people, and
sanctify them to day and to
morrow... And be ready against
the third day: for the third day

the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

Jesus was born on Earth 4000 years from the creation of Adam. The Church Age clock began ticking at the birth of Jesus. The length of the Church Age is revealed to be two days or 2000 years. If

we begin counting the days at the birth of Jesus, then after the two days (2000 years) of the Church Age, the next day would be considered the third day.

MOSES BROUGHT THE PEOPLE TO MEET GOD

Now watch how this Scriptural profile brings confirmation of God's timeline. Exodus 19:16-17:

And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud...

And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God...

Consider the fact that Moses represents

Measuring God's Timeline all of the righteous dead who died before they entered into the Promised Land, and he leads God's people out of the camp to meet with God. This again confirms the fact that the dead in Christ shall rise first. They will lead the Rapture procession to meet Jesus when He appears to catch away the Church. Then the righteous who are living at that time will be caught up together with them to meet the Lord in the air. If we apply the key, "The thing that hath been, is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done," this reveals that the Rapture takes place after six 1000-year days. It is spoken of as being the third day in the morning. We will cover the details in another pamphlet. Then the

ultimate confirmation of this timeline is found in the New Testament in Matthew 16:28. Jesus said, "... There be some standing here, which shall not taste death, till they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom." Matthew 17:1-3 says: "And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, And was

transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him."

A CLUE OF THE RESURRECTION

Here we find a confirmation in the New Testament of what the Old Testament has profiled. Again, the indication is that the Rapture takes place after six days of human history. Jesus waited exactly six days after He made that statement before He took them up to the mountain. It is also significant that it was Peter, James, and John that Jesus took with Him when He raised the dead.

I believe this information is the clue which reveals that there is a resurrection associated with the event this Scripture profiles. In this vision, which we call the Transfiguration, Jesus talks to Moses and Elijah. Now remember, Moses represented all the righteous who have lived on the Earth in the 120 Jubilees and have died before they entered into the Promised Land. Elijah was caught up alive and did not die (II

Measuring God's Timeline

Kings 2:1-3). This profiles the Body of Christ that will be caught up alive at the time of the Rapture.

When I wrote the book *End-time*Events, I was convinced that Moses
went to Heaven with Elijah in the same
chariot. The only major clue I had was
Jude verse 9: "Yet Michael the
archangel, when contending with the
devil he disputed about the body of
Moses..." It is evident that Michael is in
charge of the Rapture of the Church, for

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall

Paul said,

rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them... (I
Thessalonians 4:16-17)

These verses reveal that the righteous dead shall be resurrected as the voice of Michael the archangel is blended with the trump of God. The righteous who are alive at that time will be caught up together with them.

This gives us strong evidence that

Moses, who represents all the righteous dead of the 6000 years or 120 Jubilees, had to be caught up to heaven with

Elijah. The events recorded in Matthew

17:1-5 give an exact profile of the

Rapture of the Church after 6000 years.

But the ultimate confirmation of this is

found in the original Hebrew of II Kings 2 in the story of Elijah being caught up to Heaven in a chariot of fire.

The use of a computer program searching this text for ELS sequencing of the Hebrew letters (skipping an equal distance between the Hebrew letters) reveals a hidden message in this chapter that would seem to confirm that Moses' body was resurrected and taken to Heaven with Elijah. The first clue is found in verse one where the name Moses is found embedded in the phrase "into Heaven." This is not even in a skip sequence but in the plain text. Again, in verse eleven, the name Moses shows up in the same phrase "into Heaven." In verse three, we have a message also embedded in the Hebrew, "Head chief angel, Michael, he resurrected." In verse five, we find in the plain text (without any skips) the word "he contended."



Again in verse five, we have, "Head chief angel, Michael, he resurrected." In verse eleven, we find the name Moses embedded in the phrase, "into Heaven." Again, in verse twelve, we find the word "he contended." So it's obvious from the very first verse that Moses was taken into Heaven. The message gives strong evidence that it was the "Head Chief Angel, Michael," who contended with the devil about the body of Moses. Then the message indicates that Michael resurrected Moses. This should be confirmation enough that Jude verse 9 fits in II Kings 2. Then, in verse thirteen, we find "Yeshua" the Hebrew

name for Jesus. It is only found once in the text. All of the other confirmations are found twice.

The friend who helped me find this in the Hebrew said, "It looks as though Jesus encoded these messages in the original Hebrew and signed His name to it." (II Kings 2:1, 3, 5)


